


FachPack 2015



Persson Innovation had a successful exhibition at FachPack 2015, which was held September 29th – October 1st in Nuremberg, Germany. 4th quarter certifications

The 4th quarter will be busy while Persson Innovation is audited for various certifications. Audits for FSC®, PEFC® and ISO 9001 certifications will take place mid-November through early December. The FSC (Forest Stewardship Council) is the certification body that determines compliance with all FSC requirements. A certification is valid for five years and is monitored annually to make sure Persson Innovation continues to meet FSC standards.

The PEFC (Program for the Endorsement of Forest Certification) provides independent assessments, endorsements and recognition of national forest certifications systems. Similar to FSC, obtaining a PEFC endorsement requires independent assessments to ensure the company meets the numerous PEFC requirements.

ISO 9001 is a quality management standard that presents guidelines intended to increase business efficiency and customer satisfaction. The goal of ISO 9001 is to embed a quality management system within an organization to increase productivity, reduce unnecessary costs, and guarantee the quality of processes and products. Complying with ISO 9001 standards ensures that customers receive consistent, high-quality products and services.
